SAGE is committed to providing as accessible and equitable an experience to our users as possible, and so we thank BTAA and the Library Academic Alliance for their review of the Data Planet platform.

We regularly commission independent accessibility evaluations of our platforms including Data Planet, which was recently evaluated by Tech for All in June 2021. While we are confident that Data Planet overall provides a usable experience for most users of assistive technology, we do acknowledge that bugs, regressions, and other barriers can occur. The BTAA evaluation is very helpful to us in identifying where these persist.

We have carefully reviewed its findings and found these to be consistent with the ones found in the evaluation by Tech for All which form the basis of the current VPAT for the platform. Included below is the current version of Data Planet's accessibility roadmap which covers the short to medium term remediation plan up to Q2 2022.
