Multiple Formats: All our books are free online and in PDF formats. We also sell low-cost print copies of our books should students prefer this format. Each format can be accessed from the book's Details page by clicking on a book's cover. Choose your book's subject category from our [Subjects Page](#).

Screen Reader Compatible:

- The online/web view format of our books works with most screen reader programs, and the PDF works with PDF reader programs.
- All of the images and figures in our books also have alt tags so that the images can be cited by screen readers as well.
- Instructors have also donated Enhanced PowerPoint slides with alt text for several of our Science books. This option varies from book to book, so we recommend checking the Instructor Resources tab for your book to see if this option is available.
